Excerpt from Charter and by-Laws of the Engineers Society of Western Pennsylvania: December 19, 1906 Section 4. An Active Member shall be one actively engaged in, or who has had past experience in, the practice of engineering. He shall, at the time of admission to membership, be at least 25 years of age and shall have been in the active practice of his profession at least five years. Graduation from a technical school shall be considered equivalent to two years active practice. The performance of the duties of a Professor of any of the applied sciences or the editing of a technical publication shall be accepted as equivalent to an equal number of years of active practice. Section 5. A Junior shall have had active practice in some branch of applied science for at least two years, or have been a student of the same for an equal period in a school of recognized standing. He shall be not less than 18 years of age and shall be a person who is not eligible as an Active...
