The earthquake's damage uncovers hidden treasures from the Civil War era, and a book about Henry Box Brown, a slave born in 1815 near the earthquake's epicenter. Henry Brown's story of shipping himself to freedom in a wooden crate captivates Bailey and her neighborhood friends, who attend Earthquake School until the public schools reopen. The treasures are not the only surprises for Bailey. An early-morning knock on her grandmother's door announces unexpected visitors. This is book 9 in the award-winning Bailey Fish Adventure series.
